



Shiva Vishnu Temple COVID-19 update

On Monday June 1st, the Shiva Vishnu Temple will open its doors to the devotees for visitation during the hours of **9am - 11:30am & 6pm - 8pm** Monday thru Friday, and **9am - 11:30am & 4pm - 8pm** on Saturday/Sunday.

Devotees are requested to observe the following rules for safety:

- Devotees are advised to stay at home if they have any COVID symptoms
- Maintain Social Distancing of 6 feet while on the Temple premises.
- This is mandatory to wear a **face mask** to enter the Temple.
- Wash hands with soap and water in the Temple lobby.
- Sign in on the sign-on sheet when entering the Temple.
- Do not bring any offerings into the Temple, such as milk, fruits, flowers, prasadam, etc.
- Children should accompany parents and should stay with them at all times.
- Total number of devotees at a time in the main hall not to exceed 15.
- No sitting inside the Temple on chairs or floor.
- Temple is following the “No Touch” policy. Do not touch anything inside the Temple. Shastanga/Dandvat Pranam is prohibited
- At this time, access is limited only to the main Sanctum Hall upstairs.
- Devotees should complete their prayer and promptly leave the Temple premises. No gathering in parking lot.
- All activities, classes, programs & Sunday Mahaprasad/Lunch remain suspended until further notice.
- Devotees are requested to follow all posted signs/notices.
